As you know, I am taking Long Service Leave from the last week of Term 2 until the end of Week 6 in Term 3. Mrs Pukallus will be replacing me as Acting Principal. Congratulations to Mrs Pukallus who I know will do a great job in my absence. Mrs Brito will be joining our staff on contract in my absence. Mrs Brito will teach my classes, which is mainly Year 3 and 4 Maths and English, with Years 3-6 Health and History/Civics/Geography and also some P-6 PE. We welcome Mrs Brito and trust she will enjoy her time at Haden State School.

Report cards will be sent home early in Week 11. Please keep up the great attendance rate right to the end of the term. Every day counts. If students are not in front of us, then we cannot teach them! So turning up at school every day is a huge step in improving outcomes for our students.

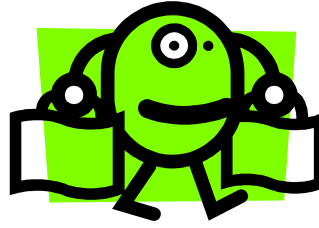
